### Day Two

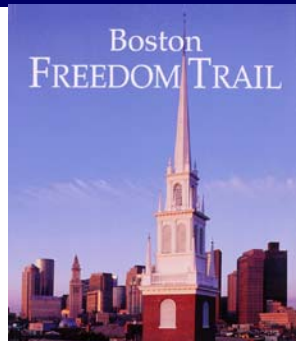
- 7:00 am - **Breakfast rotation begins at hotel**
